

# Nebraska Voter Cancellation Form

According to Nebraska Revised Statute §[32-326](#), the election commissioner or county clerk shall remove the name of a registered voter from the voter registration register and cancel the registration of such voter if:

- (1) the voter is deceased,
- (2) the voter requests in writing that his or her name be removed, or
- (3) the voter has moved out of the state.
